 (Brief appraisal of the overall performance of the institution during the preceding academic session and plans for future development)

100 Students has been selected and admitted through written entrance examination test and interview with strictly following the seat reservation and subject roistering as per university norms. Selected list has been displayed in institute website as well as in notice board for healthytransparence. Teaching was stared from 20th August 2013 to 28th June 2014. Total number of teaching days 200 and 40 days real teaching in 11 schools 15 days for pre-practice teaching (Micro-teaching) has been performed. 40 lesson plans 20 in each subject and 20 in each subject and 12 lesson planning and teaching in pre-practice teaching (microteaching) 6 lesson planning in each teaching subject has been done. 52% lessons was supervised by the teacher educators.

Videography and photograph of microteaching and real teaching has been taken for kind perusal. 2 seasonal tests has been conducted by institute 100 students has got registration and accordingly 100 students has filled in final examination form. Final examination will be held from 9th Oct. 2014 by Kolhan University. e-Library as well as conventional (Mo) computer with internet facilities, science labs, psychology lab, language lab, educational CD/ ROMs, LCD, TV/VCR public sound system, electric and generator facility and other educational facilities etc are aailed properly in the institute.

Gardening, outdoor games-football and cricket/Hockey, annual sports has been conducted by our qualified physical education instructor, Health checkup camp, micro teaching seminar, value education workshop, National Seminar with Karim City College, Jamshedpur was performed. 1 principal and 7 lectures and 2 part time lecturers on physical education and Craft- Fine Arthas been working as per NCTE norms and Kolhan University guidelines. Salary in paid to teaching and non teaching staffs through
